## Bicycle Tour Benefits Person County United Way

The **Kiwanis Club of Person County** is proud to sponsor the third annual **ALSCO Metals Corporation Mayo Lake Cyclism Saturday October 13, 2007**. This is a fully supported bicycle tour to benefit the **Person County United Way**.

The tour will start and end at Mayo Lake Park in Roxboro, NC and will travel 50 miles through the rolling farmland of Person & Granville Counties, North Carolina and Mecklenburg and Halifax Counties, Virginia. Quiet country roads with very little traffic will take cyclists from Mayo Lake to Kerr Lake and back. There will also be shorter routes of 15 and 31 miles.

In cooperation with the **Person County Recreation Arts & Parks Department** this year's tour is part of the **Mayo Lake Fall Festival**. The festival includes many other activities for the entire family. After the tour enjoy a free outdoor concert at the Mayo Park Amphitheater. Registration fee includes lunch provided by Golden Corral and T-Shirt. Golden Corral will include vegetarian options for lunch this year. The first 150 participants in the Mayo Lake Cyclism or the 5K Race in the Park will also receive \$20 of coupons from Dick's Sporting Goods.

At last year's **Lake Hyco Cyclism**, 117 cyclists raised over \$10,000 for the United Way.
