Serving Children – One Child at a Time

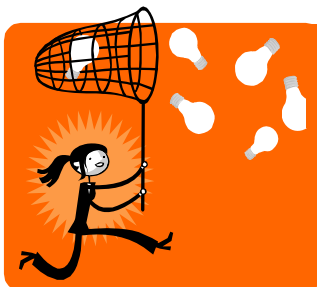

He gets up and keeps running. Chronic kidney infections, a possible kidney transplant in the near future, multiple seizures and a recent surgery on both feet, Jeremiah has been bedridden for over 8 weeks. Greenville Eastside Kiwanis pitched in and purchased a Wii game to facilitate his recovery

and occupy him during his long journey healing.
